Dear WBBC Class of '68,

Homecoming Weekend offers a myriad of events and opportunities for you to attend together.

I can't wait for you to see the beautiful Corban Campus. It is possible that some of you haven't even been on this campus since you graduated from the El Cerrito campus.

All of this information will be covered again in the Homecoming brochure being mailed to you in a few weeks. But I wanted to give you a sneak peek. Registration will begin **Friday** morning from 8 a.m. until 10 a.m. Start your weekend with a very special **Alumni Chapel** involving current students and alumni starting at 10 a.m. At noon there is a **Picnic in the Park** (our new amphitheatre) with entertainment provided by our talented students from our music department. Cost is \$10 per person.

Maybe you'd like to **golf**? You are welcome to join other alums for an afternoon at the Salem Golf Course; the cost is \$100 per person (25% of the fee goes to student scholarships). Or, you may choose to attend a **women's soccer game** or take a **guided stroll** through campus with Corban faculty/alumni guides ending up with a **reception in the newly created Alumni House**. By the way, President and Mrs. Hoff have invited alumni from the **Decades of 50s and 60s to a reception** at their lovely home (right next door to the Alumni House) on Friday afternoon at 4:30, just prior to your reunion dinner.

As I mentioned, there are many opportunities available to keep you busy or you just can sit around and visit with old friends. Your **Class of '68 private, catered dinner will be held on Friday at 6 p.m., on campus in the Pavilion**, conveniently located right next to the new Psalm Performing Arts Center, where some of your activities will be held. The cost is \$16 per person for the delicious multi-course dinner; the main entree is chicken. If you have any special dietary requirements or other needs, please let me know.

Saturday is another day full of activities starting with a **reception with faculty** (and yes there are still some around like Dr. Caulkins), followed by the **Alumni Awards Luncheon** with President

Hoff's State of the College address, musical presentations and alumni awards honoring distinguished alums. Cost is \$12. After lunch, more options offer a special **excursion to the Oregon Garden** (80 acres in historic Silverton features thousands of flowers, plants displayed in 20 specialty gardens), cost is \$10. Or **women's soccer** in the afternoon providing opportunities to spend even more time together and with other friends from surrounding classes. After all of this, you can attend a **women's volleyball game** on Saturday evening or plan a dinner on your own with your classmates.

We have made special arrangements for **accommodations with the Phoenix Inn Suites** in south Salem, which are conveniently located off Interstate 5, exit 252, and about 7 minutes from campus. They have reserved an entire floor for WBBC/Corban alums. Call 1-800-445-4498 for reservations. King suite \$74 per night, plus tax; queen double \$79 per night, plus tax. Full breakfast is provided.
