CORBAN COLLEGE MATCHING SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

The Corban College Matching Scholarship Program is designed to allow churches to help their students with tuition costs at Corban. Please read this page before signing the form.

AWARD

- Corban will match the gift up to \$500 per semester or \$1,000 per year.

POLICIES

- Awards must be from general church funds, not from individual gifts given through the church in order to get matching funds, if that money would have been paid to Corban for the cost of attendance otherwise. If a special offering is taken, it is permissible for family funds to be part of that offering; however, it should not be an inappropriately large percentage of the total.
- Funds cannot be for services rendered to the church in lieu of or in addition to salary to employees or student interns.
- For budgeting purposes, this application must be submitted by February 15, 2010 or Corban will be unable to match the funds.
- The matching scholarship should be above and beyond any regular support the church provides Corban.

PROCEDURES

- The student completes section I of the application and the church completes section II. **It is the responsibility of the student to follow up with our office to ensure it has been received by the February 15, due date.**
- Because the due date is early in the year, many churches do not know if they will be able to contribute. If this is the case, the church may fill in an estimate of how much they will provide if funding allows. Corban College will award this amount and match it up to \$1000. In February of 2011 we will check to see what amount has arrived from the church, then we will adjust our matching funds to equal that amount, up to the amount on the application or \$1000. If the church is aware before then that they will not be able to follow through with the estimate, please notify us and we can make the adjustment at that time.

- The funds may be sent to Corban in equal payments prior to the start of each semester, or in one lump sum. With each check, be sure to include the student's name and indicate what year it is designated for (i.e. 2010-2011). Our fall semester starts in August and our spring semester begins in January.
