Church / Organization Matching Scholarship Stipulations

Corban University's School of Ministry Church/Christian Organization Matching Scholarship was developed to encourage churches and Christian ministries to provide corporate scholarship support for their students involved in Christian higher education. In order to participate, ALL of the following guidelines must be followed.

1. This scholarship is awarded based on availability of designated scholarship funds on a first come, first served basis.
2. Only one church/organization scholarship check per *residency* will be matched up to \$800.00 at the ratio of 1 for every 2 dollars donated.

Example: If the church or organization sponsoring a student at CUSM gives \$1,600.00 for the upcoming residency, CUSM will provide an additional \$800.00 for that student's tuition expense. The church/organization is free to give more – all of which will be credited to the account of the student they are sponsoring. The maximum scholarship from CUSM, however, is \$400.00 per *module*. If, on the other hand, the church or organization sponsoring a student at CUSM gives \$400 for the upcoming residency, CUSM will provide an additional \$200 for that student's tuition expense. Thus, CUSM will match 50% of the amount given by the sponsoring church or organization up to \$800 per *residency*.

3. The DEADLINE for post-grad students to apply for this scholarship is September 1 – fall residency and December 1 – spring residency.
4. The STUDENT is responsible for following up with the Church/Christian Organization to ensure that the deadline is met.
