Church/Organization Matching Scholarship Stipulations

Corban University's School of Ministry Church/Christian Organization Matching Scholarship was developed to encourage churches and Christian ministries to provide corporate scholarship support for their students involved in Christian higher education. In order to participate, ALL of the following guidelines must be followed.

1. This scholarship is awarded based on availability of designated scholarship funds on a first come, first served basis.
2. The scholarship will only be awarded to students who are enrolled in 9 or more credits per semester at CUSM.
3. CUSM will match the gift up to \$250.00 per semester or up to \$500.00 per year at the ratio of 1 for every 2 dollars donated.
4. The DEADLINE for CUSM Master's degree students to apply for this scholarship is July 1 – fall semester and Dec.1 – spring semester.
5. The STUDENT is responsible for following up with the Church/Christian Organization to ensure that the deadline is met.
