REFLECTION PAPER *instructions*

The purpose of this exercise is to help you think back over your CCS experience, reflect on what you learned and apply that learning to your life.

REQUIRED FORMAT:

Your paper must be:

- Minimum one page in length
- Typed, using an 11 or 12 point font
- Double spaced
- On 8 ½ x 11" paper with 1" margins

REQUIRED CONTENT:

Follow the format outlined below in completing your reflection paper.

No title page is needed. Please put your name and campus mailbox number in the upper right hand corner of your paper.

Paragraph 1: Explain your service project and share why you selected this particular opportunity.

Paragraph 2: Share your expectations for this project. What fears or challenges did this project present for you? Were your expectations met or how were they changed?

Paragraph 3: Select and answer 3 of the following questions:

- ~ How did this project fit with your academic/career goals or your spiritual gifting?
- ~ What lessons did you learn about yourself through this experience?
- ~ What servant leader qualities did you use or develop during this project?
- ~ How has this experience shaped your perspectives on living a life of service?
- ~ What did this experience teach you about God?

Paragraph 4: Summarize your experience; share what lessons you will take away from it and how you can apply what you've learned to your own life. If you were to do this project again, what might you do differently?
