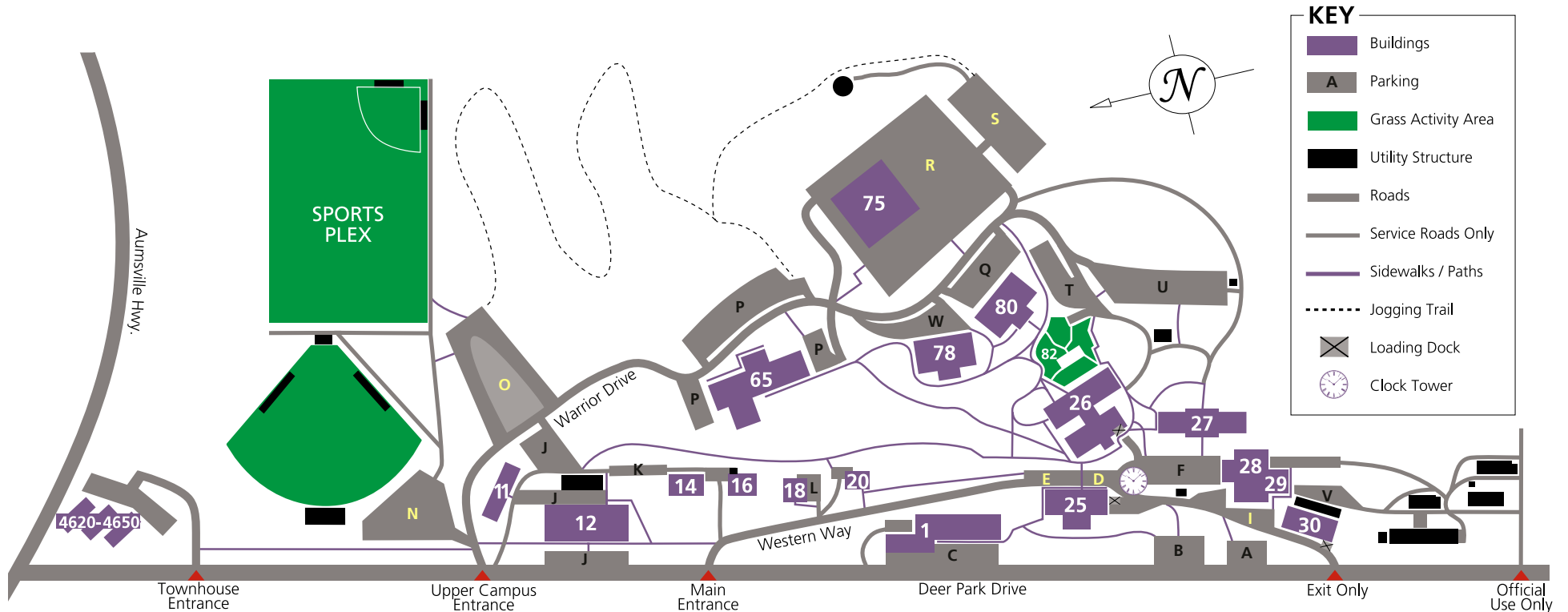

History: Founded in 1935 in Phoenix, Arizona; relocated in 1946 to the San Francisco area; to its present location, Salem, Ore., in 1969

Total Enrollment: 1,100

Accreditation: Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities. Education program approved by Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (State of Oregon) and the Association of Christian Schools International.

Directions

From Interstate 5: Take Exit 252 (Kuebler Boulevard). Turn east and follow signs. Continue on Kuebler Blvd 3/4 mile and turn right on Turner Road. Proceed 1/2 mile southeast and turn left onto Deer Park Drive (directional sign says Corban University). Continue one mile northeast to main entrance on right.

Local Traffic From Salem: From Commercial St: Take Kuebler Blvd. east to Turner Road and follow signs. From East Salem: Take Lancaster Drive south (name changes to Aumsville Hwy). Continue southeast on Aumsville Hwy. to Deer Park Drive SE, turn right and follow signs to campus entrances.
