SUMMARY: The primary responsibility of the position is teaching undergraduate exercise science courses.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Teach undergraduate exercise science courses including at least two of the following courses: Motor Development and Learning, Therapeutic Exercise, Care and Prevention, Biomechanics, Nutrition, and Human Anatomy and Physiology I, II.
- Teach subject matter in a manner that is consistent with the University's Statement of Faith with particular attention to the statement on creation
- Responsible for supervision and/or instruction of science course labs
- Academic advising and possible student research advising/mentoring
- Curriculum and program development
- University and departmental committee work
- Perform other duties as assigned

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Corban University faculty are expected to be active scholars, excellent teachers, active in service to the university and the community, and able to model the integration of faith and learning.
- Candidate should have strong teaching and leadership skills and have a demonstrated record of active participation in professional organizations.

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

- Doctorate in the area of exercise science, physiology, kinesiology, nutrition or related field is preferred. The successful candidate without a doctorate will be expected to complete a doctoral program
- Significant experience in physiological science is required and college teaching experience is preferred.
- Preference given to candidates with experience in faculty driven undergraduate research.
- Must be committed to the integration of biblical principles within their teaching, and be willing to invest in the development of undergraduate science students. The science program places



great value in collaboration and, therefore, desires candidates who have the same teamwork and collaborative values.

- Must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and evidence a mature Christian faith, and be in agreement with the University's mission and statement of faith
- Candidates should value an environment that reflects the diversity of God's kingdom, engages in global concerns and connects culturally.
