Student Right-to-Know Act
Enrollment and Graduation Rate Report

In accordance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, Corban University is pleased to share with you the following information on the graduation rates of our 2011 cohort of full-time, first-time, degree or certificate seeking undergraduates and student athletes that received athletic financial aid.

During the fall semester of 2011, 275 first-time, full-time, certificate or degree-seeking Undergraduate students entered Corban University. After 6 years 56% of these students had graduated from our institution or completed their programs.

While reviewing this information, please keep the following in mind:

- All graduation rates are based upon 6 years of attendance which equates to 150% of the normal completion time of our longest program.
- We have elected not to report transfer-out rates because our university's mission does not include providing substantial preparation for students to enroll in another eligible institution without completing or graduating.
- These charts do not identify the reasons why our students withdrew; therefore, students who withdrew for personal or medical reasons are included.
- Graduation rates do not include students who left school to serve in the armed forces or on official church missions or with a foreign aid service of the federal government, or students who died or were totally and permanently disabled.
- A pound sign (#) denotes any cohort/sub cohort with five or fewer students. The university is not required to disclose this information.

Corban University is required by the Higher Education Act to annually publish and disclose graduation rates and enrollment numbers as part of the Student Right to Know and Campus Safety Act.

The graduation rates are based on students enrolled as first time freshmen and graduated within six years. For the 2018 report this information is based on a 2011 incoming cohort.
